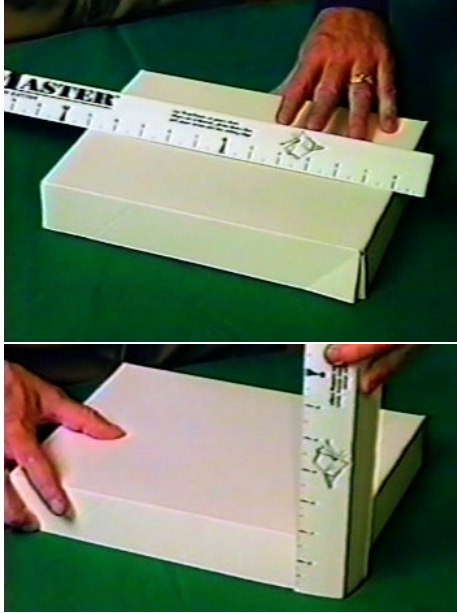


How To Use Your Wrapmaster

1 Measure the box



1. Measure the longest side and double it.
Example: The longest side of the box is 7" so the total is 14"
2. Measure the depth of the box and double it. Example: 2" doubled is 4"
3. Add the results from step 1 and step 2.
Example: $14" + 4" = 18"$

2 Measure the paper



1. Roll out a good estimate on how much paper it should take.
2. Fold the paper across the Wrapmaster as shown in the picture.
3. Adjust and repeat as needed until the number is about one inch larger than you need. (see step 1.3)

3 Cut



1. Pull the paper at an angle against the edge to make a clean straight cut.
2. Trim the paper and save the remainder.
3. Wrap your gift!
